## Kitchen Commandments

## Instructions for the use of the Church Kitchen/Fellowship Hall

If you use the kitchen and/or fellowship hall, you should do the following:

- Have enough people for set up and clean up.
- Make sure all dishes, pots and pans are washed and put into their proper places.
- All trash cans must be emptied and trash taken outside to the dumpster.
- All cardboard boxes will be broken down and taken outside to the recycle dumpster.
- All tables and chairs will be cleaned and put away.
- The kitchen and fellowship hall floors will be swept.
- All dirty towels must be taken home, washed and brought back to the kitchen.

All food that is put into the refrigerator and freezer must be labeled and dated.

Refrigerator Ex: Hotdish, UMW for April 2; or Leftover salad, please eat, toss by April 9. Freezer Ex: Enchiladas, Rick Anderson, frozen 3/30.

- Make sure all coffee machines and coffee makers are turned off, emptied and cleaned.
- Make sure all burners and ovens are turned off.
- Make sure all lights and fans are turned off.
- The last one to leave the building needs to make sure all doors are locked and the alarm has been set.
- Report to the office anything that is not operational or broken.
